



Chaka's Grand Indochina Tour

Day 01: Vientiane Arrival (breakfast included)

Arrive in Vientiane, transfer to hotel. In the afternoon, take a city tour to visit Wat Simuang, Vientiane's most sacred site, and the religious museum at Wat Sisaket, Wat Pra Keo, The Luang Golden Stupa, and the Ratuxai Victory Gate, viewing the sunset along the banks of the Mekong River. Overnight at your hotel in Vientiane.

Day 02: Vientiane - Luang Prabang (breakfast included)

Transfer to the airport for a morning flight to Luang Prabang. Hotel check-in, visit Khuang Si Falls. In the afternoon enjoy our city tour with the Former Royal Palace, Wat Xieng Thong, Wat Sen, Wat Visun. End the day enjoying the sunset from the top of Mt. Phou Si. Overnight at hotel in Luang Prabang

Day 03: Luang Prabang - Pak Ou - Luang Prabang (breakfast and lunch included)

Take a full-day boat trip on the mighty Mekong River. En route, visit the mysterious Pak Ou Caves, Continue down river to Ban Xang Hai village. After a picnic lunch, return to Luang Prabang for a short visit to the typical Lao village at Ban Xang Khong. Overnight at hotel in Luang Prabang

Day 04: Luang Prabang – Hanoi (breakfast included)

After breakfast, visit Luang Prabang Market and a number of shops selling antiques and silver jewellery made by mountain tribes. Transfer to airport for flight to Hanoi, transfer to hotel, Rest of the day free to relax or to explore the ancient streets of Hanoi. In the evening, enjoy a water puppet show. Overnight at hotel in Hanoi.



Day 05: Hanoi – Halong (breakfast,lunch and dinner included)

Arrive in Hanoi in early morning. Transfer to Halong .On arrival, a welcome drink is served on board one of our authentic Junks sailing between the limestone karsts of this stunning UNESCO world heritage sight.. Have lunch on board – seafood. A fantastic cruise in the Bay, visit Dinh Huong Island, Ga Choi Island, Sail Island, visit Sung Sot Cave and a swim at Titov Beach. Relax and enjoy sunset. Dinner - seafood. O/N on board.

Day 06: Ha Long Bay, Hanoi (breakfast and brunch included)

Light breakfast on board (cake, tea, coffee, milk). A morning cruise to visit Man’s Head Island, Tortoise Island, visit Luon Cave by small bamboo boat. Enjoy brunch on board. Check-out and transfer back to Hanoi. On the way, stopover at Bat Trang ancient ceramics village. O/n in Hanoi.

Day 07: Hanoi City Tour included Cyclo (rickshaw) – Hue (breakfast included)

Breakfast at hotel. Visit to Ba Dinh Square with Hochiminh Mausoleum, His House on Stilt, One Pillar Pagoda, visit Temple of Literature, Sword Lake with Ngoc Son Temple, The Huc Bridge, take one hour around the Old Quarter by Cyclo Transfer to the airport for domestic flight to Hue. Arrival in Hue – Pick up & transfer to the hotel. O/n in Hue.

Day 08: Hue City Tour – Hoi An (breakfast included)

Breakfast at Hotel. City tour: take a cruise on the Huong River, visit Thien Mu Pagoda, Imperial Citadel. Afternoon visit to Former King Tu Duc & King Khai Dinh Mausoleum. Depart for Hoi An. O/n in Hoi An.

Day 09: Hoi An Ancient Town Tour included Cyclo (breakfast included)

After breakfast, visit the charming and historic city of Hoi An. A rich history involving the Dutch, Portuguese, Chinese, and Japanese . Half day visit Hoi An with the ancient houses, Japanese Covered Temple Bridge, Phuc Kien Temple, and Hoi An market. Take a Cyclo (rickshaw) for a panoramic tour in the town. Free time to relax this afternoon. Overnight in Hoi An.

Day 10: Danang - Hochiminh City – CU CHI TUNNELS - City Tour (breakfast included)

Transfer to Danang airport for a short flight to Hochiminh. On arrival in Hochiminh City, pick up & transfer for a visit to Cu Chi Tunnels, well-known in the American War Time – an underground network of 200km long. During the world of independence, Vietnamese guerillas built the labyrinth of narrow tunnels virtually underneath U.S. bases, using them to hide during bombing raids and to stage surprise attacks. Back to Hochiminh City - Visit Reunification Palace, Notre Dame Cathedral, Post office. Overnight in Hochiminh city.

Day 11: HOCHIMINH CITY – MEKONG RIVER DELTA – HOCHIMINH (breakfast and lunch included)

Drive to the watery world of the Mekong Delta, just some hours by road from Ho Chi Minh City. Head south to the Mekong Delta and reach Ben Tre, crossing the Mekong River with a local ferry. Walking through fruit orchards, then ride a horse cart on the village road to see the life style of local people & pass by the green fields. Take a sampan to experience your Mekong discovery cruising small canals and arroyos lined with water coconut, & enjoying honey tea. Lunch at local restaurant with Vietnamese special dishes as “Tai Tuong” fried fish, spring rolls and shrimps. Come back to Hochiminh. Go for shopping in Ben Thanh Market. O/n in Hochiminh.



Day 12: Hochiminh city – Siemreap (breakfast and dinner included)

Breakfast at hotel. Free until transferring to airport for departure flight to Siem reap. Upon arrival at Siem Reap Airport, you will be met and welcomed by our friendly guide then transferred directly to your hotel. Start your visit to the South Gate of Angkor Thom, the famous Bayon, Baphoun, the Terrace of Temple, Elephants and Terrace of the Leper King. You will visit one of the great wonders of the world, the symbol of the heart and soul of Cambodia, Angkor Wat. Then view a spectacular sunset if your lucky from the top of Phnom Bakheng Hills. Tonight you will enjoy dinner at the Khmer Apsara Dance Show. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 13: Siemreap Tour (breakfast included)

To day we drive to visit Kbal Spean, 50km northeast of Siem Reap or 18km from Banteay Srei. The original "River of Thousand Lingams", Kbal Spean is an intricately carved riverbed deep in the foothills of the Cambodian jungle. Visit to Banteay Srei temple (10th century), regarded as the jewel in the crown of classical Khmer Art. Then continue your visit to Banteay Samre, built in the 12th century. It consists of a central temple with four wings preceded by a hall and two libraries, it is remarkably well preserved. Overnight in Siemreap.

Day 14: Siemreap Tour – Phnompenh (breakfast included)

We continue to visit the fabulous Ta Prohm embraced by the roots of enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers, Pre Rup, East Mebon, Neak Poan. Visit Krovan, Royal Bath of Srah Srang and Banteay Kdei temples. Transfer to the airport for domestic flight to Phnompenh. Overnight in Phnompenh.

Day 15: Phnompenh City tour – Departure (breakfast included)

Visit the Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda, and the Independence Monument, National Museum and Wat Phnom. Transfer to the airport for your departure flight back home.
